## Best for dramatic interiors

A little slice of Morocco right in the heart of Palma, this is an adult-only retreat with just a clutch of suites and an opulent style that bursts into life the minute you walk through the door. Stone archways and wood-panelled ceilings are offset by candlelight and scarlet-red curtains; there are chandeliers, gilt-edged mirrors and textiles with colourful patterns. In the traditional style, the hotel is set around an interior patio filled with lush foliage, bamboo seating and a tiled water feature, perfect for a pre-dinner drink, and fusion cuisine is served up in plush surrounds in the elegant restaurant Morokko.
